



Specialty Clubs

We encourage FFS students to enroll in Specialty Clubs, even if they do not participate in the Extended Day Program. Specialty Clubs take place every weekday from 3:15 to 4:15. Students who participate in Specialty Clubs will receive a small, healthy snack and have a short time for free play before the start of club. Students who do not stay for the Extended Day Program at the end of clubs should be picked up at 4:15 in front of the Meeting House.

Specialty Clubs run for 8 weeks for a cost of \$120.00. All clubs offered to students in grades 2 and up (with the exception of Homework Club) must have 8 or more students in order to run.

The following Specialty Clubs will take place during Fall, 2017:

Mondays

- **Costume Club** with *Extended Day Staff* (grades Pre-K to 2) \$120.00
Dressing up and role play is essential to child development. We'll have access to tons of dress up clothes, props, toys, and anything else your child can dream of!

Tuesdays

- **Imagination Club** with *Extended Day Staff* (grades Pre-K to 2) \$120.00
The creativity of a child is boundless! Students will invent characters, create stories, solve mysteries, and go on adventures!
- **Robotics Club** with *Teacher Dave* (grades 3 to 5) \$120.00
Students will learn about robotics, engineering, and programming using LEGO bricks and LEGO WeDo 2.0 systems. They will improve their critical thinking skills and fine motor abilities, develop teamwork and communication, and most importantly, have a blast!
- **Running the Bases** with *Teacher Tony* (grades Pre-K to 2) \$120.00
Students run the bases while playing kickball and wiffleball with their friends.
- **Cross Country** with *Teacher Elizabeth and Teacher Rachel* (grades 6 to 8) \$150.00
Students will learn the art of running as a team and will participate in at least two meets - including the Germantown Cross Country Invitational which will host 300 middle school runners at the Belmont Plateau and the small Friends schools meet at Landsdowne Friends School. Cross Country Club is a two day commitment and takes place on Tuesdays and Thursdays.

Wednesdays

- **Art Club** with *Extended Day Staff* (grades Pre-K to 2) \$120.00
Students will create a myriad of art projects including sewing projects, collages, sculpture, and more!
- **Coding Club** with *Teacher Stephan* (grades 3 to 6) \$120.00
Students can create their own interactive, animated stories using the drag-and-drop programming language Scratch and build their own video game to share with the world. They will also make use of MakeyMakeys which allow them to connect everyday objects (e.g. playdough, bananas, water) to control their own computer programs.

Wednesdays (continued)

- **Flag Football** with *Teacher Tony* (grades 5 to 8) \$120.00
Students will develop football skills and learn about sportsmanship and teamwork with an emphasis on fun.

Thursdays

- **Construction Club** with *Extended Day Staff* (grades Pre-K to 2) \$120.00
Students will use LEGO bricks, K'NEX, blocks, magnetic materials, balls and ramps, and recyclable materials to build individual and group models of their own invention.
- **Soccer** with *Teacher Tony* (grades 3 to 5) \$120.00
Students will practice dribbling, shooting, passing, trapping, and teamwork while doing drills and playing games.
- **Cross Country** with *Teacher Elizabeth and Teacher Rachel* (grades 6 to 8) \$150.00

Fridays

- **Drum Circle/Jam Session Club** with *Extended Day Staff* (grades Pre-K to 2) \$120.00
Students will let loose – inventing new sounds, creating new rhythms, and singing freely.

Monday through Friday

- **Homework Club** with *Extended Day Staff* (grades 1 to 8) *for Extended Day participants only
Students will take this hour to begin homework assignments or to do quiet activities. Extended Day Staff is available for assistance (note that Homework Club takes place for one hour only. Students may bring any work not completed home with them for the evening).
